Terms & Conditions

- Maintenance is to be performed and tracked at the recommended intervals specified in the operator's manual for Cervus Protection Plan coverage to apply.
- Transportation of the equipment, travel by our service department to the equipment, or other expenses, such as overnight hotel stays, will be the responsibility of the customer to pay.
- Equipment must be operated exclusively within its rated capacity as specified in the covered equipment's operator manual.
- Any issues with respect to the performance of the covered equipment must be promptly reported to Cervus Equipment. The equipment must be protected from further damage when a failure occurs.
- Any failures due to pre-existing conditions will not be covered by the warranty.
- Exploratory dismantling of the covered equipment will not be covered by the warranty.
- The invoice for any costs not covered by the Cervus Protection Plan will be settled directly with Cervus Equipment at the time of repair.
- Normal maintenance parts and service items will only be covered by the Cervus Protection Plan if they are required to be replaced as a direct result of a covered failure.
- The warranty terms may not be altered or extended.
